Brass Audition Requirements

Brass Music Majors

Students who are auditioning as a brass major (trumpet, french horn, trombone, euphonium, and tuba) should prepare 2 contrasting selections (no more than 2 minutes in length each) that best reflects their musical talent on their primary instrument. Students will also be required to play their chromatic scale (preferably 2 octaves) to demonstrate range and control. A small ear training and music theory placement test will be administered after the audition.

Brass Non-Music Majors

Students who are NOT auditioning as a major but for a non-major scholarship should prepare one solo, etude, or technical study on their primary instrument and should reflect your best performance abilities.
