Nonresident Tuition Waiver:

Incoming international freshmen, transfer or graduate students who live on campus may be eligible for a scholarship waiving 50% of their **nonresident tuition**. This program waives only a percentage of the nonresident portion. Interested students must complete a general scholarship application.

Undergraduate Admissions Graduate Requirements

You must be a graduate from an accredited high school or have a high school equivalency diploma. To enroll you must meet the following performance requirements:

Have a minimum high school 2.7 GPA

AND

Minimum TOEFL score of 61 or IELTS score of 5.5 or Duolingo 85 or PTE Academy 42

OR

Have a minimum high school 2.7 GPA and a transcript showing your high school diploma was completed within the United States or from an NSU-approved, native English-speaking country

Graduate Admissions Requirements

You must have earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. If you have earned your degree outside the U.S., you must submit a course-by-course WES or ECE evaluation. To enroll you must meet the following performance requirements:

Minimum TOEFL score of 79 or IELTS score of 6.5 or Duolingo 100 or PTE Academy 58

ΔND

A grade point average of 2.5 based on a 4.0 scale on all undergraduate coursework attempted

OR

A 2.75 based on a 4.0 scale in the last 60 semester hours of undergraduate coursework attempted
