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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All university core and pre-professional courses must be successfully completed prior to beginning upper-division nursing courses.

Minimum overall GPA (retentive) of 2.5 in all coursework must be completed at the time of application.

A minimum of "C" in the following courses: Biology, Chemistry, Microbiology, anatomy, Physiolgy, Introduction to Nursing and Individual and Family Development.**

- **1.** Three satisfactory references
- **2.** Criminal background check
- **3.** Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
- 4. Application packets are available from the UCO Nursing Department.
- 5. TOEFL score of 530 or greater is required for international students.

Class Size: 60 Students

Application deadline is the last Monday of January for fall admission; the second Monday of September for spring admission.

*Science GPA (required courses) will be considered equally important as overall retentive GPA if the minimum 2.5 is met.

**A minimum of 2 of the 5 required sciences must be completed by the application deadline.

Students transferring to the University of Central Oklahoma from other institutions are expected to fulfill all requirements specified for regularly enrolled students. The lower division nursing courses (NU RS 1221 – Intro to Nursing) must be completed at UCO before the first semester of the junior year of nursing.
