#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

#### **Admission Requirements**

- All university core and pre-professional courses must be successfully completed prior to beginning upper-division nursing courses.
- Minimum overall GPA (retentive) of 2.50 in all course work completed at the time of application. \*Admission to the Nursing Program is competitive. For the recently admitted class, the average retention GPA was 3.40 with a science GPA of 3.34.
- 3. A minimum of C in the following courses: Biology, Chemistry, Microbiology, Anatomy, Physiology, Introduction to Nursing, and Individual and Family Development\*\*
- 4. Three satisfactory references
- 5. Criminal background check
- Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
- 7. Application packets are available from the UCO Nursing office.
- 8. TOEFL score of 530 or greater required for international students.

## Class Size: 60 Students

#### **Application Deadline**

Last Friday of January for fall admission - Second Friday of September for spring admission

\*Science GPA (required courses) will be considered equally as important as overall retentive GPA if 2.50 is met.

**Students transferring** to the University of Central Oklahoma from other institutions are expected to fulfill all requirements specified for regularly enrolled students. The lower division nursing courses (NU RS 1221 – Introduction to Nursing and NURS 2113 – Individual & Family Development) must be completed at UCO before the first semester of the junior year of nursing.
