Admission Requirements

- All university core and p re-professional courses must be succe ssfully completed prior to b eginning up perdivision nursing courses.
- 2. Minimum overall GPA (retentive) of 2.50 in all course work completed at the time of application. *Admission to the Nursing program is competitive. For the recently admitted class, the aver age retention GPA was 3.40. science GPA was 3.34.
- 3. A minimum of "C" in the following courses: Bi ology, Ch emistry, Microbi ology, Anato my, Physiology, Introduction to Nursing, and Individual and Family Development. **
- 4. Three satisfactory references.
- 5. Criminal background check.
- 6. Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS).
- 7. Application packets are available from the UCO Nursing.
- 8. TOEFL score of 530 or greater required for international students.

Class Size: 60 students.

Application Deadline

Last Monday of January for fall admission. Second Monday of September for spring admission.

*Science GPA (required courses) will be considered equally important as overall retentive GPA, if 2.50 minimum met.

**A minimum of 2 of the 5 required sciences must be completed by the application deadline.

Students transferring to the University of Central Oklahoma from other institutions are expected to fulfill all requirements specified for regularly enrolled stu dents. The lower division-nursing courses (NURS 1221 - Intro duction to nursing) must be completed at UCO before the first semester of the junior year of nursing.
