2. Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
3. Submit no more than a two-page essay (double-spaced) describing a “particularly rough patch” you have recently encountered and specifically how and why you intend to persevere in your studies at NSU. (see website for examples)
4. Finalists will be asked to complete a video interview at NSU that may be used by NSU for fundraising and other purposes.
