

# University Housing Checklist of What to Bring to Campus



*This is a partial list of items you may want to bring when moving into the residence halls at NSU. Even though each residence hall is unique, all rooms are equipped with a bed (twin xl or full depending on location), dresser, wardrobe or closet, desk and chair as well as cable and internet connections. If you have any questions or concerns about specific items, please do not hesitate to contact the Housing Office.*



### Roommates/Suitemates

Before you bring these items, check with your roommate or suitemates first!

### Poster Guidelines

Chances are, you will want to hang items on the walls of your room. Please be advised that the following items may damage walls:

- Poster Putty
- Adhesive Squares
- Duct/Scotch/Electrical tape
- Thumb Tacks
- Nails/Screws

We encourage residents to use 3M strips and masking tape to hang items in their room. Hanging any items from the sprinkler pipes is not allowed.

Any damage not noted on the residents' inventory card will be billed to resident upon checkout at the end of the semester.
