Safety is one of the top concerns for both students and parents. Enter GuardianSentral™, a new smartphone application for use at Northeastern State University.


GuardianSentral™ is free and can be downloaded to iPhone and Android touch screen devices as **Illume Guardian**.



THE APPLICATION FEATURES THREE MODES:

Danger

- » Requests an emergency response
- » Calls the campus police, sends the phone's GPS coordinates and tracks the device until deactivated by a passcode

Follow me

- Follows if the user is not comfortable with their environment
- Notifies campus dispatch and tracks the phone using GPS for a period of time (User may also request an officer for escort)

Check-in

- Allows user to notify campus dispatch of a chosen destination and anticipated travel time
- » Confirms arrival at a destination by GPS (If an arrival is overdue, the user's designated contact people will be notified)

Activation of the application notifies the Tahlequah dispatch, but branch campus police will receive immediate alerts of requests from Broken Arrow and Muskogee campuses. The user must register the app with a personal profile that includes their name, cell phone number and a pass code. The GuardianSentral™ application is being designed by Tulsabased Illume Mobile - a division of MacroSolve.
