## **MAP-Works (Making Achievement Possible) Scholarship Overview**

*Deadline: April 13, 2013*

The **MAP-Works Scholarship** is a national essay contest for first and second-year college students who have participated in the MAP-Works program. EBI MAP-Works created this scholarship to highlight the experiences and achievements of MAP-Works students. This scholarship is intended to assist students in helping to reduce the cost of their college education. Scholarships will be awarded for the 2013-2014 academic year. Each scholarship is worth \$1,500.

In order to be eligible for and receive the MAP-Works Scholarship, students must:

- **Attend a college/university that is a current MAP-Works partner**
- **Be enrolled in either the first or second year at their institution**
- **Have participated in at least one MAP-Works survey during the 2011/12 or 2012/13 school years**
- **Complete an application cover page**
- **Submit an essay of no fewer than 800 and no more than 1,600 words addressing one of the following three essay questions:**

*1) How did MAP-Works affect your college experience?*

*2) What did you learn from the MAP-Works student report that caused a change in your college behavior?*

*3) Was there a person who reached out to help you who had information from MAP-Works? How did that person affect you?*

***\*IMPORTANT: Please do not put the name of your institution in your essay.***

**due no later than April 13, 2013.**
