- 3. The panel chair may be an undergraduate student, graduate student or faculty member. The chair is responsible for introducing the participants, moderating audience questions, and keeping the time.
- 4. The respondent must be a graduate student or faculty member. The respondent is responsible for talking about the papers and offering suggestions for furthering the research.


