- ✓ Automated Telephone Request 1-800-908-9946. Request your Tax Return Transcript
- ✓ Paper Request Form - Go to www.irs.gov. Enter 4506-T in search box. Print the form, fill out completely and submit directly to the IRS (requested transcript will be mailed to the filing address of record with the IRS).

- ✓ Please provide a copy of your W-2(s). If you do not have a copy, you may request your wage and income transcript from www.irs.gov
