NSU's Fall 2019 Community & Collaboration-Assessment Day, will be held Wednesday, August 14, 2019 on the Broken Arrow Campus. This year's keynote will Dr. Marie Baehr. She will speak about her experience with assessment. Dr. Baehr started her academic career in 1989 as a faculty member in physics at Elmhurst College (IL), becoming Elmhurst's first Associate Dean, in charge of assessment, in 1998. In 2007, Dr. Baehr assumed the chief academic officer role at Coe College (IA), where, since 2016, she serves as Special Assistant to the President.

Dr. Baehr has been interested in discovering meaningful ways to determine actual student learning since the early 1990s, having authored articles on assessment and evaluation in Pacific Crest's *Faculty Guidebook*. Since 2004, she has mentored and facilitated at the Higher Learning Commission's Assessment Workshops and Academy events as well as at HLC's Persistence and Completion Academies.

Dr. Baehr earned her undergraduate degree from Denison University (OH), her M.S. from the University of New Hampshire, and her Ph.D. from the Ohio State University.
