

Pre-Physical Therapy

It should be emphasized that "Pre-Physical Therapy" is NOT a major. It simply means that the student is meeting requirements for matriculation. Academic requirements for transferring vary by institution. To be eligible for application, you are advised to complete the following courses.

Additional Comments

- Students may need to take additional or different classes if applying to schools outside of Oklahoma
- Student should double check the application deadlines and start dates for the programs as these vary
- For support during application student should contact the Pre-Health Advisor
- Students need to have earned a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university by the time the begin the PT program at either institution
- It is recommended that students have a minimum cumulative and prerequisite grade point average of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale for all college work attempted
- Have completed all department pre-requisite courses with grades of C or better
- Document 50 hours of observation experience in a variety of physical therapy settings <u>prior to application</u>. The number of required hours varies by school.
- Submit Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores.
